New Mangere (Auckland) Depot Marks a Milestone in Loscam's New Zealand Growth

A modern facility elevating service capability and supply chain efficiency across New Zealand



Loscam has taken an important step in its New Zealand growth story with the opening of a new state-of-the-art depot in Mangere, Auckland, in June 2025. Strategically located at 13 Freight Place in one of Auckland's busiest logistics hubs, the new facility is designed to better support the fast-evolving needs of the country's grocery and fresh produce sectors.

Built Around New Zealand's Supply Chain

With easy access to key transport routes, including Auckland Airport and the Port of Auckland, the Mangere depot places Loscam closer to its customers than ever before. The site's location enables faster repair, washing, loading, and storage operations, helping to shorten turnaround times and lift efficiency right across the supply chain.

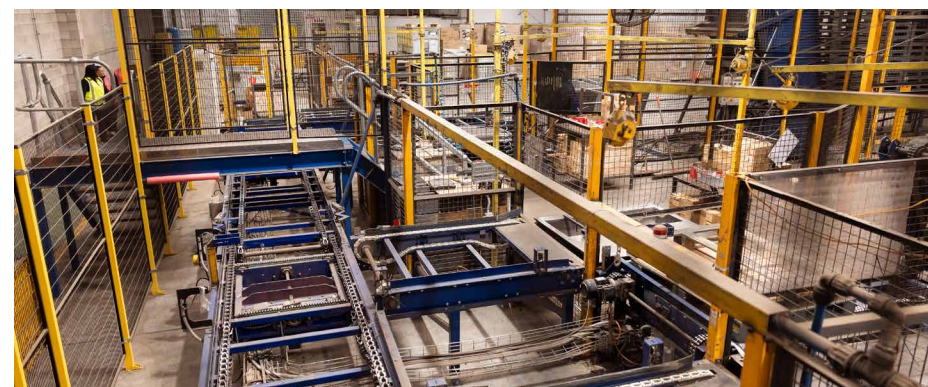
The opening ceremony shone as a milestone for Loscam's ongoing growth since re-entering the New Zealand market in 2012. The ribbon-cutting ceremony brought together senior leaders including Group CEO at the time, Sirin Limpaitoon, then EVP of ANZ and now Group CEO Daniel Bunnett, CFO Linda Tsui, and New Zealand Country Manager Bryan Wardrop, collectively

symbolizing the unity and strategic vision driving this expansion.

Designed with Purpose, Ready for Growth

Step inside the Mangere depot and it is clear the facility has been configured with both precision and purpose. Each operational zone from pallet handling through to crate washing — follows a carefully designed workflow that maximizes quality, efficiency and safety.

A modern pallet repair area, featuring four repair lines and integrated conveyors, ensures consistent quality and reliable



performance across Loscam's wooden pallet pooled assets. For fresh produce crates, a dedicated washing facility supports strict hygiene requirements and food safety standards that are critical to New Zealand's grocery and produce industries.

In addition, new state of the art drying technology ensures crates are delivered to customers dryer than ever before. Beyond pallets and crates, the site also includes dedicated wash bays and expanded yard capacity to accommodate bulk containers, bins, and IBCs. This boosts both cleaning capability and storage efficiency, enabling faster customers turnaround and



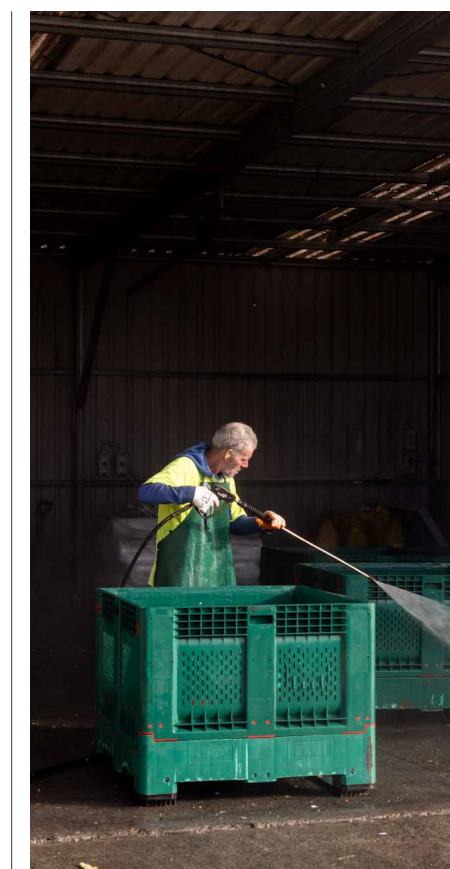
improved quality.

Powered by People, Focused on Service

For Loscam, the new depot does not just deliver improved infrastructure, it also strengthens relationships with customers. Sirin described the facility as a "key milestone" that reflects Loscam's long-term dedication to the local market and its unique supply chain needs. Over the years, growth in New Zealand has been driven by passionate teams who understand the needs of grocery, consumer goods, and fresh produce customers.

Daniel Bunnett highlighted the importance of this expansion: "Our Mangere depot is a further key milestone demonstrating to the local market our long-term commitment. The growth of our New Zealand business is driven by a passionate local team dedicated to better supporting the market. This new facility not only increases our capacity for future growth but also delivers immediate benefits such as improved access and reduced loading times for our customers."

Strengthening Taiwan's Supply Chain: A New Chapter Begins with Loscam Taoyuan Depot 1



Eight years after first establishing a presence in Taiwan, Loscam has opened a new chapter in its growth journey with the launch of Taoyuan Depot 1, its first self-operated facility in the market. Located at No. 48 Sande Street, Luzhu District, Taoyuan City, the new depot marks an important step in Loscam's long-term commitment to the Taiwan market, supporting local customers with enhanced service quality and faster operational response.

Building a Stronger Connection with Customers

Since entering the Taiwan market, Loscam Taiwan has steadily expanded its pallet pool, supporting a growing network of manufacturers, retailers, and logistics providers. Previously, core operations such as pallet issuance, dehire and repair were managed at external partner's site. With the launch of Taoyuan Depot 1, these essential services are now fully in-house, enabling closer control, faster turnaround, and even higher service standards.

Strategically positioned within Taiwan's key logistics corridor, the 2,000-square-metre facility is designed to handle every stage of asset management—from sorting and storage to repair and dispatch. By managing the full asset lifecycle in one place, Loscam can better support customers to improve their supply chain efficiency — helping

reduce downtime, minimize waste, and keep supply chains moving smoothly.

Designed for Efficiency, Built for Growth

Designed for high performance, Taoyuan Depot 1 features organized process zones that streamline pallet flow—from inbound receipt and sorting, through quality inspection and repair, to dispatch. The on-site repair capability upholds consistent product standards, extends product lifespan, and supports resource efficiency through reuse.

For customers, the benefits are immediate. Local stockholding allows Loscam to respond faster during peak seasons or promotional surges. With operations closer to key customers and major transport corridors, the depot enhances responsiveness during seasonal demand surges and enables more

efficient planning, helping reduce logistics costs and environmental impact.

A Moment to Celebrate

On 28 October 2025, Loscam officially opened Taoyuan Depot 1 with a ceremony attended by over 50 guests, including customers, suppliers, business partners and Loscam regionals' team members. Loscam's leadership team was well represented, with Daniel Bunnnett, then EVP of ANZ (now CEO), Linda Tsui CFO, Kenny Tan EVP of SEA, Patrick Chan, VP of EM, and Chung, General Manager of Taiwan joining Philip Boa, Board representative of Mubadala to mark the occasion.

During the ceremony, Linda described the opening as a proud achievement that underscores Loscam's commitment to Taiwan and its customers. She thanked partners for their trust and the team for their dedication,



reaffirming that Loscam will continue to expand its network and uphold its reputation for reliable, high-quality service.

Representing Mubadala, Philip Boa emphasized the depot's strategic significance. "The opening of this depot represents not just physical growth—but our shared vision and commitment to accelerate Loscam's development across the region." He reiterated Mubadala's support for Loscam's continued success and its intention to work closely with the management team in Taiwan and across Asia, while expressing appreciation to customers for their ongoing support.



Service First, Future Focused

For General Manager Chung emphasized Loscam's core philosophy, the new depot reflects Loscam's identity as a service-first organization. "People often ask which industry we belong to—logistics or leasing—but in truth, we're in the service industry," he shared. "Our responsibility is to make sure our customers can operate with confidence, knowing their supply chains are supported every step of the way."

Looking ahead, Chung revealed that the name "Taoyuan Depot 1" was chosen intentionally—to signal Loscam's future vision. "We named this warehouse 'Taoyuan Depot 1' to signal the beginning of further expansion—to Depot 2 and eventually southern Taiwan. This new facility represents our ongoing commitment to our customers and the Taiwan market. We will continue to earn your trust with reliable service and innovation."

The launch of Taoyuan Depot 1 not only strengthens Loscam's operational foundations in Taiwan but also sets the stage for broader regional development. Lionheart Farms Partners with Loscam to Elevate Hygienic Liquid Logistics Across the Philippines



Lionheart Farms (Philippines) Corporation, a leading organic coconut producer in Southern Palawan, has transformed its inter-site logistics with Loscam's Intermediate Bulk Container (IBC), enhancing hygiene, efficiency, and sustainability across its operations.

Pioneering sustainable agriculture

Founded in 2015, Lionheart Farms (Philippines) Corporation has built a pioneering model of sustainable and regenerative agriculture by cultivating coconut palms across Southern Palawan and connecting local farmers with global markets. By 2018, the company established its first food and beverage factory, producing organic, high-quality coconut-based products that reflect its commitment to responsible sourcing and value-added processing. Sustainability sits at the heart of Lionheart's business, with organic farming methods and regenerative practices driving the development of innovative products and setting a benchmark for responsible agriculture in the Philippines.

The Challenge: Maintaining High Hygiene Standards in Multi-Site Logistics

As Lionheart's footprint expanded across multiple sites in Palawan, the company

needed to maintain stringent food safety standards while managing transportation efficiency and storage conditions in a tropical climate. Packaging had to withstand high humidity, frequent rainfall, and potential pest exposure, while remaining cost-effective and compliant with food-grade requirements.

The business initially relied on paper IBC for bulk liquids, but these proved unsuitable for long-term storage and inter-site transfers, particularly for intermediate liquids exposed to weather, chilled environments, or longer dwell times.

Lionheart required a reusable, durable, and hygienic solution that could move seamlessly between sites without compromising product integrity or operational efficiency.

The Solution: A reusable, hygienic solution with Loscam IBCs

In 2024, after evaluating several options, Lionheart identified Loscam as its preferred logistics partner, attracted by its expertise in

returnable packaging and pooling systems across the Asia-Pacific region. Loscam responded with its i8 and i6 Intermediate Bulk Container solution, designed specifically for high-hygiene liquid applications and challenging storage environments.

The i8 IBC's robust hard-plastic frame, reusable structure, and high-hygiene inner liner system aligned closely with Lionheart's operational and environmental objectives, particularly for chilled or humid storage conditions where protection against contamination and moisture is critical.

"The Loscam IBCs meets all our requirements for inter-site logistics—ensuring cleanliness, reusability, and waste reduction while maintaining product safety," a Lionheart spokesperson noted. This alignment allowed Lionheart to integrate the new containers with minimal disruption while reinforcing its sustainability commitments.



Sustainability Impact: Cutting waste - 50 Tons saved annually

The shift to Loscam's returnable IBCs has also generated significant environmental benefits for Lionheart Farms. By replacing single-use paper IBC, the company estimates an annual reduction of approximately 50 tons of paper waste, directly lowering its reliance on disposable packaging materials. This move not only reduces landfill impact but also contributes to a smaller carbon footprint and more efficient resource use across the supply chain.

These gains dovetail with Lionheart's broader sustainability strategy, reinforcing its position as a champion of regenerative agriculture and responsible manufacturing in the region. The partnership demonstrates how reusable logistics solutions can support both environmental stewardship and operational performance in the food and beverage sector.

Positive Reception and Future Expansion

The internal response to the Loscam i8 IBC has been overwhelmingly positive, with teams highlighting easier handling, improved durability, and enhanced storage efficiency. Early results from the initial rollout show clear operational benefits: better warehouse organization, fewer damage or pest-related issues, higher safety and stability during stacking, and improved packaging integrity that supports both federal and export standards.

With business volumes rising and multi-plant processing expanding, Lionheart expects Loscam IBCs to play an even more integral role in its logistics network. By 2026, the company anticipates circulating 1,000 or more Loscam i8 units across its sites and partner facilities, making Loscam's IBCs the primary solution for intermediate product movement and supporting Lionheart's continued growth and international expansion.

Enabling sustainable growth

As Lionheart Farms scales its operations, the collaboration with Loscam illustrates how innovative reusable packaging can underpin high standards of hygiene, safety, and sustainability in food-grade logistics. "Loscam's IBCs solution plays a key role in enabling our vision for sustainable growth," Lionheart noted, encouraging other companies to consider returnable packaging as a reliable, cost-effective way to improve operational efficiency and environmental performance.

IBCs Performance in Action: Durability, Safety & Operational Efficiency

Since adopting the Loscam IBCs, Lionheart has observed measurable improvements across operations, particularly in Durability & Hygiene Performance. The rigid plastic body protects liquids from external factors such as moisture and pests, while only the inner liner requires replacement, significantly reducing cleaning cycles and contamination risks. Both the discharge valve and cap incorporate lock-and-seal mechanisms supporting secure handling during transport and storage and enhancing overall Product Safety.

The IBCs' stackable design enabling units to be safely stacked up to five high has helped Lionheart optimize warehouse footprint and maintain cleaner, more organized facilities. The handling process is compatible with existing equipment and workflows, and transition from paper IBC to Loscam's reusable solution was seamless, with teams quickly adapting to the new system.



From Waste to Value: Loscam's Smart Solutions Transform Food Processing Efficiency

At FoodTech QLD 2025, Australia's premier food manufacturing event held at the Gold Coast, Loscam demonstrated how its new solutions can help manufacturers achieve greater efficiency, reduce food waste, streamline operations, and accelerate sustainability across industries.

Welcoming over 3,500 professionals from across Australia's food manufacturing and processing sectors, the exhibition spotlighted two of Loscam's proprietary solutions—the SQUIZ Station and the Intermediate Bulk Container (IBC) pooling system. Together, these technologies tackle one of the industry's biggest pain points: product waste within packaging systems.

Smarter Design, Stronger Impact

The SQUIZ tool, engineered to optimize wastage inside Loscam's IBCs, enables near-total evacuation of bulk liquid and semi-liquid products. In doing so, it dramatically reduces leftover material, the hidden source of food loss and cleaning inefficiencies in processing operations.



Integrated with Loscam's IBCs, this modular system offers a scalable, end-to-end solution that enhances hygiene, cuts product loss, and boosts supply chain sustainability metrics. These advancements directly support manufacturers' compliance with tightening environmental and waste reduction standards shaping Australia's food sector.



Driving Industry Collaboration

Beyond showcasing technology, Loscam's participation at FoodTech QLD underscored its longstanding commitment to strengthening industry-wide collaboration and elevating best practices across the food manufacturing sector.

A key focus of this collaborative approach was Loscam's active involvement with the Australian Institute of Packaging (AIP), a leading authority in packaging education and innovation. By contributing insights on circular packaging models, material optimisation, and the role of pooling systems in reducing environmental impact, Loscam reinforced its reputation as a strategic partner that provides more than just equipment solutions to customers but works with its customers to deliver innovation, continuous improvement and industry transformation.

These interactions served as a platform for knowledge exchange, enabling stakeholders to explore how smarter packaging technologies can close waste loops, improve resource utilisation, and accelerate progress toward national sustainability goals. 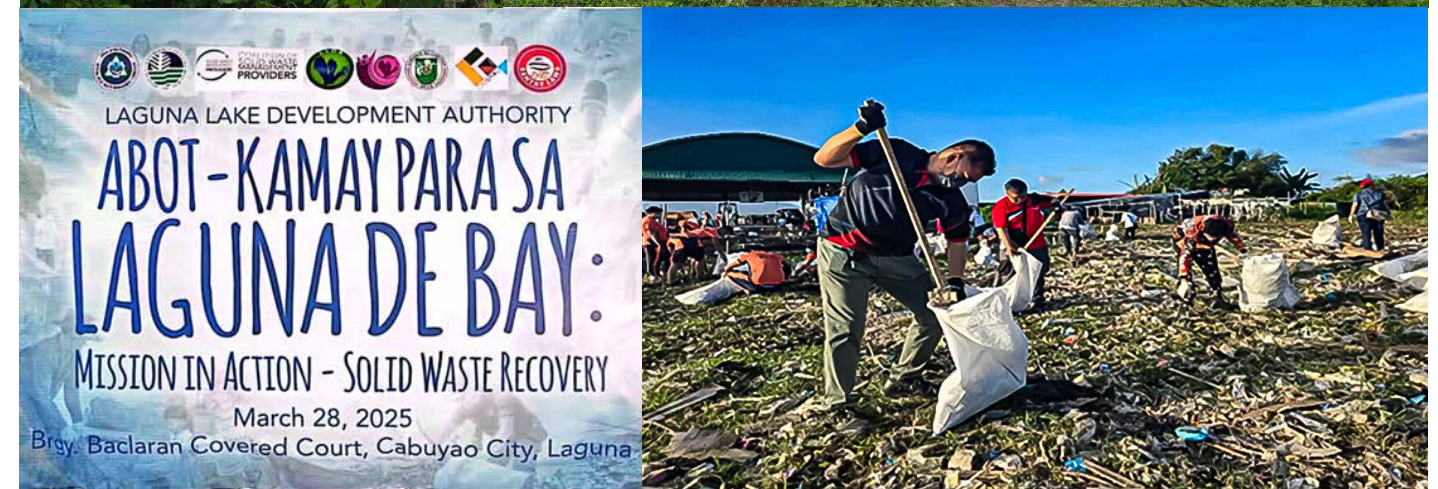

about protecting vital waterways and natural habitats. The company takes pride in these tangible contributions to conservation.

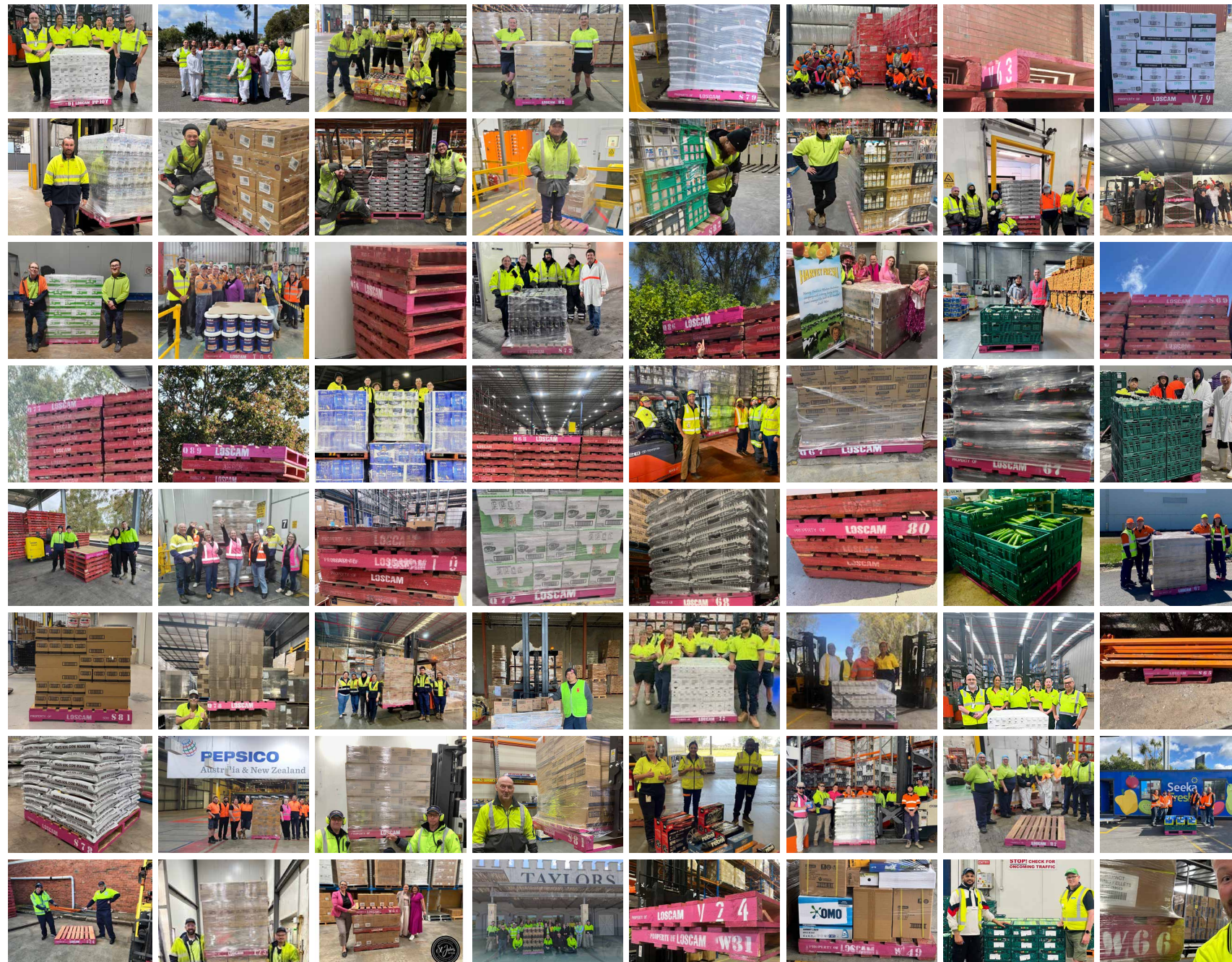
